

GDPR INFORMATION CLAUSE

Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (OJ EU.L.2016.119.1) (hereinafter "GDPR"), I inform that:

1. Personal data controller - Article 13 (1)(a) GDPR

The controller of Your personal data is the Regional Volunteer Center Association based in Katowice (hereinafter referred to as "Controller" or "Association"), address: ul. Warszawska 19, 40-009 Katowice, contact email: katowice@wolontariat.org.pl

2. Purpose of processing of personal data and legal basis for processing - Article 13(1)(c) GDPR

Your personal data will be processed for the purposes of:

- a) to carry out recruitment for volunteering - on the basis of consent in accordance with Article 6(1)(a)GDPR;
- b) to conclude an agreement and carry out volunteering - on the basis of the agreement in accordance with Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR;
- c) the Controller's legal obligation in accordance with Article 6(1)(c) in connection with the Act of 24 April 2003 on public benefit activities and volunteering;
- d) in the case of giving additional consents - on the basis of Article 6(1)(a) GDPR to the extent and for the purposes indicated in the content of the consents,
- e) in the case of possible disputes, personal data may also be processed in order to assert claims or defend the rights of the Controller - on the basis of Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, which constitutes the so-called legitimate interest in asserting claims and defending the rights of the Controller.

3. Information on categories of recipients of personal data - Article 13(1)(e) GDPR

- a) employees, associates, members, volunteers and volunteer coordinators of the Association who are authorized to process volunteers' personal data in connection with the performance of their duties,
- b) suppliers of technical and organizational services for the Association (in particular, suppliers and entities specialized in providing technical support for information and communication systems),
- c) entities entitled on the basis of legal regulations
- d) the Event Organizer

4. Transfer of personal data to a third country or international organization - Article 13(1)(f) GDPR

The Association will transfer your personal data to recipients located outside the European Economic Area (countries of the European Union and Iceland, Norway and Liechtenstein) and international organizations. The data will be transferred for the purpose of issuing accreditation by European Athletics based in Switzerland.

5. The period for which the personal data will be processed - Article 13 (2) (a) GDPR

If your application for volunteering is not accepted, your application will be disposed of three months after the negative review. In the case of acceptance for volunteering, the Association will process your personal data until the execution of the agreement, as well as after its termination for purposes related to the enforcement of claims in connection with the execution of the agreement or performance of obligations under the law.

6. Rights of the person whose data is being processed - Article 13(2)(b) and (c) of the GDPR

You have the right to access, correct, erase, restrict processing of your personal data, the right to object to processing and the right to data portability. If you have given your consent, it is possible to withdraw your consent at any time. The exercise of the right to withdraw consent does not affect the processing that has taken place up to the moment of withdrawal of consent.

7. Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority - Article 13(2)(d) GDPR

You have the right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.

8. Obligation to provide data - Article 13(2)(e) of the GDPR

Providing your personal data is voluntary, but necessary in order to participate in the recruitment process and the implementation of volunteering. Failure to provide data necessary for the conclusion and implementation of the agreement may be a reason for refusal of admission to volunteering.

9. Information on automated decision-making - Article 13(2)(f) GDPR

You will not be subject to decisions made by automated means (without human involvement). Your personal data will also not be used for profiling.
